Jesus is the Lord of All
(Jesus is the Lord of Life and Death)
Romans 14:7-9

1. Jesus' Lordship is All Encompassing

The Apostle Paul was addressing personal conflicts the church in Rome was experiencing over matters of food, faith, and rules of Christian living.

He is teaching us here that, as Christians, we can rise above the inevitable conflicts of life if we remember that Jesus is Lord: each of us belongs to Him, no matter what - in life, in death, and everything in between. Jesus is Lord, and His Lordship transcends the circumstances of our lives. He is bigger than the world, greater than life and death. No matter how deep, broad, high, wide your troubles may seem, remember: the Lord Jesus is better.

2. Jesus' Lordship is Powerful and Enduring

Some of us may be thinking that we somehow *make* Jesus Lord by calling Him so, or that we *keep* Him Lord by hanging on to Him with a tight spiritual grip. No, no! Jesus is Lord because Jesus overcame death and lives forever.

He died for our sins on the cross, and rose from the dead victorious, therefore, He is Lord. The proof is in His nail scarred hands, pierced side, His ascension (what a great word) to heaven, His reign in exalted authority. Jesus is Lord, whether you like it or not. Jesus is Lord, whether those troublesome people in your life like it or not.

Jesus' Lordship is more powerful than anything in creation, and it will endure until ages upon ages of eternity pass...it will endure forever.

Confess today:

Lord Jesus Christ, I thank You for dying
and rising for me. Help me to live and die
for You.
