Today's Sermon Outline **A Revival of a Dead Life** 2 Chronicles 7:14

Humble yourself before God

God promises that when we humble ourselves before Him, He will hear, forgive and heal us (James 4:6). How can we humble ourselves before God?

Honor God's Lordship

Honoring God's Lordship means that you acknowledge that God is the master of your life. You acknowledge that God is the owner of everything you have- your life, time, possession, job, talents etc. You are just God's steward, and whatever you do, you do it to serve God's will (Luke 17:10). If you honor God's Lordship, your confession should be like this: "*All that I have, all that I can do, achieve and gain are not mine but yours O Lord. So I give glory to you for my achievement. I give glory to you for my success. I give glory to you for my talents.*"

Accept God's sovereign will

By accepting God's sovereign will in your life you will be able to humble yourself before God. It means that in all things happening in your life, either good or bad, easy or difficult, you trust that God's will is higher than your understanding. It is to trust God's goodness in all things happening in your life. This is what Job experienced in his life (Job 1:21, 42:5).

Come to God with a broken spirit

You can humble yourself before God by coming to Him with a broken spirit. Psalm 34:18 says, "*The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.*" When you come to God with broken spirit God will revive your dead life (Luke 18:9-14).

Seek God's face

Pray earnestly

As the merciful Father, God hears when His children seek Him through earnest prayer. We can see a good example of this in king Hezekiah's life. One day he got very sick. The prophet Isaiah delivered him God's message that he would die of the illness. Near the time of death, he desperately sought God's face through tearful prayer. And God mercifully heard him and prolonged his life 15 more years (Isaiah 38:2-5). A tearful prayer is an expression of earnest prayer. God honors such a tearful prayer (Psalm 3:4). When you are tempted to quit any task in your life with hopelessness, try tears. Seek earnestly the Lord's mercy by crying out to Him.

Turn to God

You can seek God's face by turning away from your ways and turning to Him (Isaiah 55:6-7). God is a Holy God so His presence cannot be mixed with any sin. Your sin affects your relationship with God. If you confess your sin and willfully get out of your sinful way and return to God, God will accept you immediately and revive your dead life (Psalm 32:5, 1 John 1:9). God speaks to your conscience to stop sinning while you are still sinning. But if you do not listen to Him, He will not force you to listen to Him. He will patiently wait for you until you listen. Why? God wants to have a heartfelt loving relationship with you. When you are ready to listen to God, He will help you get out of your sinful ways and turn to Him. And He will revive your dead life.

Application

1. There are three ways to humble yourself before God who will revive your dead life- honoring God's Lordship, accepting God's sovereign will, and coming to God with a broken spirit. Specify how you can do each of the three ways.
2. How can you make your prayer an earnest prayer through which God will revive your dead life?
3. How does God help you turn away from your sinful ways and turn to Him?
